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We have taken the most popular origami designs from around the world and placed them within the pages of this book. When most people think of "origami," the picture that usually jumps to mind is that of the paper crane. The crane, which represents luck, hope and happiness, has come to be a highly-recognized symbol in the West of the ancient paper-folding tradition.

This model has both colored and white parts, as Mouse has a white tail. Such a technique of using different colors of each side of paper is called inside-out. Though the technique itself is not new, its name has spread out because of "Origami Inside-Out" by John Montroll, which contains only inside-out models. Note that "inside out" also means thoroughly. On the other hand, the outside surface of a Bird base is covered by only one side of paper, and the inside surface by only the other side. Such property is called one-sidedness, as coined by Kadi Husimi. It also becomes an interesting condition from a geometrical point of view.

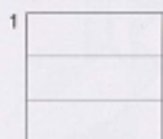
